Who is the FLIGHT Team?

The FLIGHT Team is comprised of a diverse group of professionals, including psychologists, guidance counselors, administrators, police officers, emergency management responders, security personnel, and teachers. The Team members have participated in a Prepare Crisis Management Training and have a variety of experiences in crisis response.

When will the FLIGHT Team respond?

The FLIGHT Team provides trained professionals upon request to serve schools/districts in the Carbon and Lehigh Counties that are in need of crisis response and trauma.

For example:

- Death of a student or staff member
- Trauma caused by car accidents
- School shootings
- Natural catastrophic events
- Suicides
- Child abduction



Who can we assist?

The FLIGHT Team members will assist students, staff, administration, and community members in helping to gain an understanding of grief, coming to terms with loss, and support the grieving process, while improving school climate.

What services will the FLIGHT Team provide?

The FLIGHT Team will assist schools/districts in providing immediate crisis intervention services as well as training for post-vention activities to meet the needs of the school and community.

- Administrative Support and Guidance
- Education on Trauma and Grief
- Individual Crisis Intervention
- Group Crisis Intervention
- Management of Media
- Identification of At-Risk Students
- Support Existing School Crisis Teams

How much does this service cost?

There is no cost for this service; however, if a FLIGHT Team response is initiated, the team may request:

- Drinks & light snacks
- Supplies
- Duplicating service
